

COMMON RESEARCH AND TECHNOLOGY DEVELOPMENT HUB (CRTDH)

The Common Research and Technology Development Hubs (CRTDHs) have been established by the Department of Scientific and Industrial Research (DSIR), GoI. The objective is to foster industry-institution interaction and address the problems faced in translational research by the MSEs thereby providing an eco-system for research and innovation in the country.

With a view to make best use of the CSIR technologies for the benefit of public and society, TSCOST has requested DSIR, GoI to consider for designating TSCOST as the TSCOST-DSIR-Poly-Technology Transfer & Facilitation Centre to function as a bridge between DSIR Projects, CSIR Laboratories and the State Government, Universities etc.

As a measure of furthering CRTDH activities, TSCOST and CCMB would jointly and separately make efforts for popularizing the facilities created at CRTDH for the benefit of different stake holders.

The facility was visited by the Member Secretary, TSCOST to initiate steps in this direction.
